Taste the Local Brew

Relax in one of North Idaho's award winning pubs and watch brewing history in the making. **Trickster's Brewing Company** opened in 2012 on Schreiber Ave. between Hwy 95 and Ramsey Road off Kathleen Ave. Brewmaster Matt Morrow and his staff use only the finest hops, malt, yeast and water available to create iconic brews. Stop by for a tour and stay for a pint or two of Cougar Bay Blonde, Bear Trap Brown, Coyote Morning IPA, or Inspector Stonewall's Amber Ale as well as a rotating variety of seasonal beers. Growlers and fills are available for purchase. New for summer 2013 is an outdoor beer garden open Thursdays-Saturdays. www.trickstersbrewing.com

Just opened in 2013 is **Slate Creek Brewing Company** in Coeur d'Alene. Their beer names fit the outdoor themed tap room - Norse Nectar, 6 Weight IPA, Salmon Run Red, Backcountry Brown, Harpers Stout, Double Black IPA, Camp Chair Cream Ale, Alpenglow Amber, and Piloting Mountainman ESB. The tasting room is open Thursday-Saturday with indoor and outdoor seating. Growlers and fills available with a Mug Club to come.

Established in 2010, the **Kootenai River Brewing Company** overlooks the Kootenai River in Bonners Ferry. Always on tap are the American Pilsner, Huckleberry Wheat, American Pale Ale, IPA, and Porter. Two seasonal, special brews are also on tap that vary during the year including Imperial IPA, Red Winter Ale, Scottish Ale, Rye Ale and with more to come. All their beer is brewed with locally grown North Idaho Hops, fresh Selkirk Mountain creek water, and local malt barley when available. The brewery is open daily,

has a family restaurant serving lunch and dinner, and a summer beer garden. Growlers and fills are available. Ask about "Growler Wednesdays". www.kootenairiverbrewingcompany.com

Laughing Dog Brewery in Sandpoint was started in 2005 by Fred and Michelle Colby and their "laughing dog", Ben. The brewery features a tap room, daily tours and a gift shop. To date, Laughing Dog has brewed over 15 distinct beers.

Brothers Mickey and Duffy Mahoney opened **MickDuff's Brewing Company** in 2006. Located in downtown Sandpoint, the brewery offers six year round beers and a variety of seasonals. Locals or frequent travelers may join their Mug Club. Growlers and fills are available for purchase. Open 7-days a week, there is a family-friendly restaurant on-site.

BiPlane Brewing Co. off Hwy 41 in Post Falls opened in 2011 serving up hand-crafted ales named after vintage aircraft such as the BiPlane Pusher, Gloster Gladiator, Sopwith, Rumbler Red, Curtiss Jenny, and Bristol Bulldog. They offer Party Pigs (2.25-gallons of craft beer in a handy Carry Cooler) to-go as well as Growlers and fills.

Located on Seltice Way in Post Falls is **Selkirk Abbey**. Established in 2012, the Belgian themed brewery has five year round beers: White, Deacon, Saint Augustine, Saint Thomas and Infidel; as well as five seasonal beers and one or two "occasionals". Growlers and fills are available.

In keeping with the town's colorful past, visitors to the **Wallace Brewing Company** and Orehouse Tasting Room in Historic Wallace can enjoy beers with mining and bordello-inspired monikers such as Dirty Blonde Ale, Jackleg Stout, RedLight Lager,

Vindicator IPA and 1910 Black Lager. Established in 2009, the tap house is open Tuesday-Saturday.

Also in Wallace is the **North Idaho Mountain Brewery / City Limits Pub & Grill** which opened in 2011 adjacent to their RV park. Mountain Top Amber, Summit Gold, Loft Honey and Sunset Red are offered in their pub. A "one stop vacation spot", you can stay and drink beer or drink beer and stay. Open daily.

For the barley-hop connoisseur, don't miss the annual **Bikes, Brews & BBQs** in June at the Kootenai County Fairgrounds (www.northidahofair.com), the **MicroBrews Festival** in August at Silver Mountain in Kellogg (www.silvermt.com), the micro-brew tasting event at **The Festival at Sandpoint** (www.festivalatsandpoint.com) or **Wine, Stein & Dine** in Post Falls in March.

There are many popular North Idaho **wine tasting** events but if you aren't here to catch one, **Pend d'Oreille Winery** in Sandpoint offers daily tastings of their award winning wines. **Coeur d'Alene Cellars** (on Schreiber off Kathleen Ave.) is open for tastings and tapas at the winery. Wines created from local and regional fruits, berries and rhubarb can be sampled and purchased at **Sheppard Fruit Wines' Tasting Room** on Hwy 97 in Harrison. 689-WINE

Daanen's Delicatessen (corner of Prairie and Government in Hayden, 772-7371) offers a variety of beer and wine tastings year round as well as a huge selection available for purchase.
